## 72nd Annual Norman Macbeth Invitational



The Macbeth honors Norman Macbeth, one of Wilshire's most distinguished Members. Norman was an outstanding amateur golfer, a distinguished golf course architect and a founding member of Wilshire.

Norman's achievements as a player include victories in the Southern California Amateur Championship in 1911 and 1913, the Open Championship of India, and many others. Throughout the early days of Wilshire, Norman was a frequent partner in four-ball exhibitions against visiting professional golfers. His opponents included Walter Hagen, Gene Sarazan, Jim Barnes (U.S. Open Champion) and George Duncan (British Open Champion).

As a golf course architect, Norman was involved in the design or renovation of numerous California golf courses. The list includes San Gabriel, Midwick, Annandale (renovation), Los Angeles CC (original) and of course, Wilshire.

Norman was a friend and playing partner of Alister Mackenzie, the famed architect of Augusta National, Cypress Point and many other prominent courses. In his book *The Spirit of St. Andrews*, Dr. Mackenzie labeled the 18th hole at Wilshire as "magnificent," observing that it "has not a single bunker, but owes its excellence to a large deep arroyo running diagonally almost the full length of the hole."

Norman was Wilshire's second President. He was also President of the Southern California Golf Association, the California Golf Association, and the California Senior Golf Association. In 2009, the Southern California Golf Association honored Norman by inducting him into its Hall of Fame. Probably no one man has contributed more to golf in California.

Norman passed away in 1940. The Macbeth is a tribute to the man, his contribution to golf, and his memory.

**FORMAT** A 54 hole, stroke play, two-man tournament.

### **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 3**

Better Ball of Partners. Gross & Net. Handicaps calculated at 80%.

### **SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4**

Better Ball of Partners. Gross & Net. Handicaps calculated at 80%

### **SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 5**

Both balls in play, total combined gross, less total combined full handicaps. Both balls must be holed out.

### **NOTES**

Soft spikes are required for the Macbeth. Participants' individual scores for each of the three rounds to be scored, attested, and posted for handicap purposes. The final round will be designated as a "Tournament Round."

### **ENTRIES**

Entrants are limited to those receiving invitations. Partners must be from the same club. Invitations are not transferable.

### **ENTRY FEES**

The total amount of \$2,000 (\$1,000 per player). All entry fees will be billed back to your home club.

### **HANDICAP / INDEX**

No entrant shall have a Slope Index exceeding 13.2 and a player may not voluntarily reduce his index. The lowest index of the previous 12 months as of August 15, 2021. There can be no more than a six-stroke differential between partners. The Macbeth Committee reserves the right to modify any participant's handicap at its discretion.

### **PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded at the Sunday Event to the 10 low net and five low gross teams. Members of the low net team will be declared the official Macbeth Champions. No team may win more than one prize. In the case of a tie for first place in the gross or net fields, a sudden death play-off on a gross basis (no strokes) for each will be held immediately following conclusion of Sunday's play. Ties for other prizes will be broken by matching scorecards on the last day of play and thereafter in accordance with recommended USGA procedure.

### **NINE-HOLE EVENT**

On Thursday, September 2 — at 3:00 PM, there will be a nine-hole shotgun modified Scotch (both players tee off) tournament played in sixsomes. Each team will receive a handicap based on 20% of the combined team handicap. The Committee will select 33 teams to play in the event. From a \$100 per team buy-in, the total pool will be divided between the four low net teams and one low gross team.

### **PRACTICE ROUNDS**

Contestants are invited to play one practice round on Tuesday, August 31 (PM only), Wednesday, September 1 (All Day), or Thursday, September 2 (AM only). Note: Email [golfshop@wilshirecountryclub.com](mailto:golfshop@wilshirecountryclub.com) to schedule practice round.

# PACE OF PLAY



Thank you for your efforts to improve pace of play. The Tournament Committee will continue to monitor pace of play by assisting teams to maintain their proper position on the golf course, dispatching marshals and tournament officials to warn those out of position and assess penalties to those that are unreasonably out of position. Our goal this year will be to complete Better Ball rounds in four hours and fifteen minutes (4:15) or less and to complete the Aggregate round in no more than four hours and thirty minutes (4:30). To assist you in this regard, we will be providing you with a marker's scorecard that will have "time par" listings that indicate where you should be at certain intervals.

All players in our field will be expected to play efficiently and manage their time between shots. We also expect that you will keep pace with the group ahead of you. If you should fall out of position, please do what you can do to catch up (including playing "ready golf" and picking up on Better Ball days when you are out of the hole). We also ask that you alert one of our marshals if the group ahead of you is not keeping up with the group ahead of it. They will attempt to remedy the situation as soon as possible.

We want all the participants to enjoy their rounds at the Macbeth and thank you for your continued attention to improving the pace of play at this year's event.
